

Guidelines for Student Transportation

Student transportation, a major function of the school operation, requires special attention in order that the greatest benefit will accrue from the dollars expended. The following major objectives will serve as a guide in the management of pupil transportation:

1. To furnish transportation to those pupils whose health or distance from the school makes this service essential.
2. To provide the safest possible transportation.
3. To operate transportation efficiently and economically.
4. To adapt transportation to the requirements of the instructional program.
5. To maintain conditions on the buses which are conducive to the best interest of the pupils.
6. To promote a sympathetic public understanding of the entire transportation program, including safety, adequacy, efficiency, and standards of service.
