Dear Future Fourth Graders & Parents of Fourth Graders,

As we come to the close of another school year, your 2010-2011 teacher would like to welcome you to fourth grade. Fourth grade brings big changes for everyone! In order to have a successful year, please practice multiplication facts (0-12), and read and write as much as possible.

You will be taking three state assessments (tests) next year in the areas of ELA (reading, writing, and listening), mathematics, and science. These tests will take place in January, March, and May.

Knowing that everyone is looking forward to the summer and fourth grade, I wanted to give you an opportunity to have a head start on the school year. The following materials will be needed for 4<sup>th</sup> grade:

- 6- 2-pocket folders (red (ELA), yellow (Math), green (Science), blue (SS), purple (Reading), and any design (Homework Folder)

**Note: the reason for this is we are trying to stay consistent with the colors used throughout the school for different subject areas and this enables the students to stay better organized.**

- 2 – spiral notebooks (different colors)
- 2 dozen No.2 Pencils (not mechanical)
- 4 – packages loose leaf paper (wide-ruled)
- 2 boxes of 1 gallon storage bags
- 1 black Sharpie permanent fine point marker
- Highlighter - any color
- 2 - Glue sticks
- 5 - packages 3x5 index cards
- 1 package colored pencils

Please do **NOT** send in 3-ring binders or Trapper Keepers, due to the amount of space they take up in the students' desks.
