

UNITS OF CREDIT & HIGH SCHOOL HOMEROOM STATUS

In order for a student to become a member of the 9th grade homeroom he/she must have successfully completed grade 8 or be placed there per recommendation of the District PPS (Pupil Personnel Services) Team.

A 9th grade student is assigned to a “cohort” with other entering 9th grade students and remains part of that cohort for all related graduation requirements put forth from the state. That cohort becomes the 9th grade homeroom and remains together for all class activities. If a student falls behind on required units of study and it becomes apparent that an additional year is required to graduate, then that student may be reassigned to become a part of another homeroom.

Conversely, should a student accelerate and desire to graduate early, once that student earns enough credits that early graduation appears imminent, then they will also be reassigned to the next homeroom. It is important to note that any fundraising that a student participated in remains with the class that they participated with while raising those funds.
