SPECIAL DISTRICT MEETINGS CALLED BY PERSONS OTHER THAN THE BOARD OF EDUCATION

The Board of Education may call a special district meeting when a petition is presented to them calling for such a meeting. The petition shall state the purpose for the meeting and shall be signed by 25 qualified voters or 5 percent of the number of voters who voted in the previous annual election, to be determined by the number of persons recorded on the poll list; whichever shall be greater. The Board shall proceed to call such a meeting by giving notice thereof within 20 days thereafter unless:

- 1. The purpose for which the meeting is being sought to be called is not within the power of the voters of the district.
- 2. That such purpose is illegal.
- 3. Another valid reason exists for refusing to call such a meeting, which when appealed to the Commissioner of Education shall be deemed by him to be sufficient cause for refusal.
