

CURRICULUM REVIEW AND DEVELOPMENT

The Board of Education shall direct a continuing evaluation of the curriculum as part of a program of instructional improvement.

The principal shall involve the teaching staff and others as appropriate in a systematic evaluation of the curriculum. Each area will be reviewed at least once every five (5) years for appropriateness and, when necessary, modified to reflect changes which evolve from research, local, state, and/or federal mandates. Outside consultants may be used to assist in this process.

The principal shall make recommendations to the superintendent as to any curriculum changes or modifications. The superintendent will then make recommendations for action by the Board of Education.

The Board of Education may invite teachers or others to discuss the curriculum with them.
