TEXTBOOKS FOR PRIVATE SCHOOL ATTENDEES

The Board of Education of the Sharon Springs School district is cognizant of the needs of resident students who attend other educational institutions.

In recognizing its responsibilities pursuant to Education Law 701 the Board further requires:

- 1, All written requests for textbooks from another school where a Sharon Springs resident will be attending must be received by the Board of Education prior to June 1 of the upcoming school year.
- 2. The requested textbooks must be non sectarian and must be designated for use in any public elementary or secondary schools of the state or approved by any school board.
- 3. Approved textbooks will be loaned to the student with responsibility for loss, damage or destruction the obligation of the student's parents.
- 4. Encyclopedias, newspapers, audio-visual materials and review books are not considered textbooks.
- 5. All additional provisions of Education Law 701 are applicable.
