## QUALIFICATIONS OF MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION

Every school board member must meet or adhere to the following qualifications:

- 1. Be able to read and write.
- 2. Be a qualified voter of the district (a citizen of the United States, 18 years of age, not be adjudged incompetent nor be a convicted felon).
- 4. Candidates for office of the school board must have been a resident of the school district for one (1) year prior to the vote.

## Other requirements:

- 1. School board members cannot attend meetings via telephone or remote access and cannot vote by proxy.
- 2. School board members may not reside with another member of the same school board as a member of the same family.
- 3. School board members cannot be employees of the District nor may they hold another incompatible office.

## Examples of Grounds for Removal (not all inclusive):

- 1. Failure to maintain residency.
- 2. Failure to attend 3 consecutive meetings without excuse and permission
- 3. Failure to maintain confidentiality of information learned in executive session.
- 4. Neglect of duty, willful violation or willful disobedience of a law, rule, regulation or order or official misconduct.
