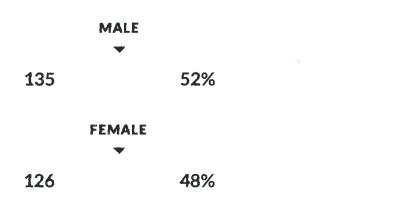

ENROLLMENT BY GENDER



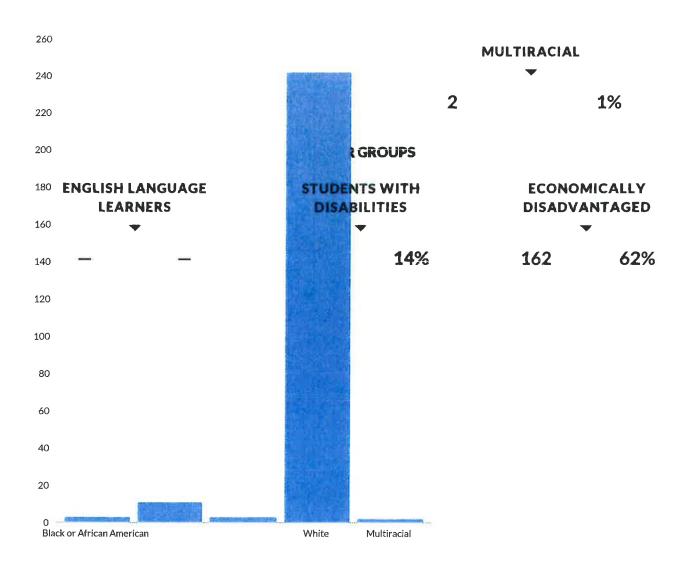
