STUDENT TRANSPORTATION IN PRIVATE VEHICLES

When providing transportation for their children, parents should drop off/pick up students at the appropriate designated time and place.

Generally, district employees are discouraged from transporting students in private vehicles. However, it is recognized that situations may arise necessitating student transport in a privately-owned vehicle. In such an event, only the Superintendent of Schools or his/her designee may transport students for the following reasons:

- 1. To transport one or more students to a hospital or other medical facility;
- 2. To transport one or more students' home for medical treatment or because of illness;
- 3. To transport student(s) to school-related events when regular transportation is not warranted; or
- 4. To transport the student home from school due to a disciplinary infraction following parental contact and no other transportation is available.
