We apologize for the inconvenience this adjustment may cause for families. Student safety is the district's first priority and therefore the decision was made to use an emergency closing day for Monday, April 8th, 2024.

On April 8, 2024, a total solar eclipse will be visible across portions of North America, presenting a valuable educational experience. This rare phenomenon will cast its shadow across the United States, with Sharon Springs finding itself near the path of the totality. The eclipse is expected to begin in Schoharie County at 2:10pm and peak at 3:20pm

Please note: It is crucial to remember that looking directly at the sun, even during an eclipse, can cause permanent eye damage. Special eclipse glasses will be provided to all students at the end of the day on Thursday, March 28th. We hope families are able to take advantage of this opportunity.
